

Regulations for participants



These regulations contain important information for you as an OMG 2024 participant.

Regulations for participants in OMG 2024:

By agreeing to your registration you automatically accept our house rules for participation, please read these rules carefully.



BASECAMP:

1. The basecamp at Vlagheide in Eerde is divided into several zones, each with its own theme.

- A: **Displays** living history, this zone contains displays from various periods. The majority is WW2, supplemented with various other periods such as Korea, Vietnam, Cold War and others. Clothing and props should be appropriate to your display.
Notice!
In this area, you are coöperating with the educational program!
- B. **Army green**, this zone contains vehicles and tents with decorations in perfect style of the military vehicle.
- C. **Various army** vehicles and armytents where the decoration does not necessarily have to be in style with your vehicle.
- D. **White** civilian camp, this area is screened from the rest of the field, and is suitable for caravans, campers and civilian tents.
- E. **Arena**, in this area you can present your vehicle to the public and there is possibility of off-road driving. * (only during public opening hours)

* Only in the zones A - B - C - D overnight parking is possible.
Public has no access in zones D and E.

- 2. There will be no electricity at the camp sites, however, there will be an option to charge phones, laptops, tablets, photo cameras at a central point within the grounds. Illegal tapping of electricity will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 3. Showers and toilets are available on the grounds, including limited facilities for the disabled.
Please do not unnecessarily soil the facilities, and be energy conscious.
- 4. Between 22:30 - 07:00 (night) the overnight camp must be quiet.
Use of generators is allowed only from 7:00 - 22:30.
Driving of vehicles is not allowed between 22:00 - 07:00.
- 5. Deposit waste only in the marked locations, including cigarette butts.
The site is an important nature reserve which we would like to preserve.

6. No pets are allowed on the entire premises other than leashed dogs. Please clean up after yourselves at all times.
7. Open fire in any form is strictly prohibited!
8. In and near the central catering facility it is not allowed to use your own drinks and/or food. Participants may purchase discounted food vouchers.
9. There is no WIFI facility available, also network connections may leave something to be desired in this outdoor area.
10. **First aid** is available on site, and will be prominently displayed. Flag Heath grounds and access roads are secured 24/7.
11. Only walking speed is allowed on the grounds. Pedestrians and organizations always have priority!
12. Upon arrival you will be assigned a place based on your registration. Please take your neighbors into account when setting up your camp.
13. Civilian vehicles are not allowed on the basecamp, you can park them on the nearby parking lot. (opposite the basecamp entrance)
14. Instructions from the organization must always be followed.
15. An access pass or day pass is required for staying at the base camp and using the facilities offered.
16. Citizen trucks, trailers, semi-trailers, flatbed trailers, etc. Cannot be parked at basecamp. If consulted in advance with the organization, perhaps something can be arranged nearby, perhaps for a fee! In all other cases, you must arrange something yourself.

The above camp rules apply throughout basecamp Vlagheide.

WEAPONS:

1. Weapons and/or ammunition are permitted only if notified digitally in advance with a submitted copy of weapons permit.
2. During your stay at Vlagheide, you must deposit your weapons at the central storage facility in a locked room.
You must take out insurance for the weapons.

Further guidelines will be issued by the Police in due course.

DEFILÉ Hell's Highway participation:

1. Participation is possible with an Allied Army vehicle in military style from period 40-45. Civilian vehicles in style from period WW2 only possible after approval of the organization.
2. Attach the vehicle sign issued to you clearly visible on your vehicle, and show your entry badge upon request.
* **Note!** The pass is also required for access to the basecamp.
3. Re-enactors may participate without an army vehicle if dressed in WW2 outfit, you must arrange your own transportation during the Defile.
4. Preferably wear appropriate clothing during the parade out of respect for the veterans. WW2 civilian clothing is also allowed. Medals and rank distinctions may only be worn if they match your attire.
5. Your vehicle must meet all legal requirements, and you must be able to show the proper paperwork.
6. All instructions of the organization must be strictly followed.
7. Whoever does not comply with the regulations will be excluded from participation. In case of gross violation, the Police will be called in by the organization.

GENERAL:

With your enrollment, you agree to the above rules.

Acceptance of your registration can be refused by the board without reason. Your registration fee will in that case be fully refunded.

After acceptance of your registration no refunds are possible.

If you are excluded from (further) participation due to irregularities experienced by the organization, you cannot claim a refund.

The organization or board of OMG 2024 is not liable for any damage directly or indirectly resulting from participation in this event.

The registrant declares that he/she is participating in this event at his/her own risk.
